Applications are invited for the Management & Operation of Pakistan Petroleum Exploration & Production Data Repository from well reputed and experienced companies/organizations.

2. Bid Documents can be obtained from the office of the Directorate General of Petroleum Concessions, Petroleum House, G-5/2, Islamabad during office hours on a written request and payment of a non-refundable fee in favour of DGPC of US \$100 (or equivalent in Pak Rupees) through Bank Draft. Bidders may request a clarification on any aspect of tender document till 25th November, 2024.
3. Interested companies should drop sealed applications along with bid documents in the Bid Box placed at DGPC, Petroleum House, G-5/2, Islamabad, not later than 11:00 a.m. (PST) on 5th December, 2024. Bids will be opened on the same day at 12:00 noon (PST) by the committee.
4. Bids submitted by all applicants will be considered as irrevocable and unconditional. In case any applicant states otherwise, his bid will not be accepted and will be treated as "non-responsive".
5. The successful applicant will be selected in accordance with the rules/process defined in the bid documents. The Authority also reserves the right to cancel or annul the bidding process without specifying any reason.
